Annotation

Mtskheta Heritage Monuments, which have been in the World Heritage List since 1994, Due to inappropriate management and chaotic development, in 2009, by the decision of the World Heritage Committee, Mtskheta was in the list of endangered world heritage.

This action was one of the most important steps to improve the condition of Mtskheta World Heritage Monuments, which led to the 2016 decision of the World Heritage Committee regarding the return of Mtskheta historical monuments to the main list. At the same time, a number of actions which the state should implement to ensure the universal value of Mtskheta World Heritage Sites.

These requirements must be regulated by international and local legislation and regulations that are discussed in the work, which has both national and international meaning.
