Geoecological assessment of the relief of Samurzakano

Historic Samurzakano Territory, which includes the Gali and Oчамchire municipalities occupied by Russia since 1993. Thus, this detailed study of this area has not been implemented during this period, which highlights the actuality of the inquiry. The area of Samurzakano is an interesting region with natural conditions, but it can not be beneficial for our country, because Georgian jurisdiction does not apply to this area.

Despite the great difficulties that accompanied the survey, the assessment of the territories in field conditions resulted in many interesting geographical issues. Based on the basin survey of rivers in the Samurzakano area, geo-tectonic territories were detected, and then studying of natural disasters in the field of expedition. Also, the settlement of the settlements was estimated and the vilages that have stopped functioning. Following the Conflict, Field Fixing and creating mapping on them results of the survey can be used in assessing sustainable development of Samurzakano territory in the future.
